

Grant Township Monthly Board Meeting

August 9th, 2022

The Grant Township board meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Supervisor Archambo.

The pledge was recited by all.

Board members present: Supervisor Gil Archambo, Trustee Eric Boyd, Trustee Shawna McManus, Treasurer Rachel Vallance, and Clerk Theresa Berden. With 5 residents present.

Addition to agenda: None

Motion to accept the agenda with additions: by Treasurer Vallance and supported by Trustee Boyd. All approved, motion carried.

Motion for the approval of minutes from the July 12th, 2022 meeting, by Trustee Boyd and supported by Trustee McManus. All approved, motion carried.

Clerks Report: Primary election complete; adjustment to pension plan to match IRS changes; PIE board meeting, will RSVP for Treasurer Vallance; federal mileage rate raised to .625

Treasurer's report: General IMMA cash on hand as of 6/30/22 was: \$55,082.95. July deposits were: \$57,286.81 and with a transfer to Checking of \$22,792.00; with a balance on hand as of 7/31/2022 of \$89,577.76.

General Fund Checking cash on hand as of 6/30/22 was \$1.68. July interest was \$.50. July deposits were \$22,992.50. July disbursements were \$22,992.91 for a balance on hand as 7/31/2022 of \$1.27.

Municipal Money Market worth as of 7/31/2022 was \$89,577.76. General Fund Checking worth was \$1.27, and Investments on Deposit was \$243,133.93 for a total net worth of \$332,712.96, which is \$79,996.45 more than the total worth this month last year.

Motion to approve the Treasurers report, by Trustee Boyd and supported by Trustee McManus. All approved, motion carried.

Public Speakers: Roberta Matelski spoke regarding the County Commissioners meeting. Judge Aaron Gauthier spoke gave an update on his court, including Recovery Court and court being back in person, though video feed is still available.

Public Comment: Resident submitted a blight complaint from herself and neighbors regarding a home on Black Lake that was not being maintained; board accepted the complaint and agreed to observe the property prior to the next meeting.

Old Business: none

New Business: A resolution regarding providing PIE&G right of way access for broadband service was reviewed by the board. A motion was made by Trustee Boyd to approve the resolution with support by Treasurer Vallance. Roll call: Archambo: yes; Berden: yes; Boyd: yes; McManus: yes; Vallance: yes. All approved, motion carried.

Supervisor Archambo provided a written copy of a blight complaint made by a resident regarding a burnt structure on Trudeau Road; the board accepted it and agreed to observe the property prior to the next meeting.

Clerk Berden will add a Blight section to the agenda moving forward.

Meeting Reports: Trustee Boyd reported on the Planning Commission meeting, Road Commission and Oakhill Cemetery

Supervisor Archambo gave update on issues with Krause Rd that was brought to the attention of the Road Commission.
